Club Rides

In keeping with Government and British Cycling guidance, there are no club rides at the moment.

As soon as restrictions are relaxed the Sunday club run will return, along with any other runs that our members request.

We need to hear from you about types of rides you want us to lead. We may not be able to do them this year, but it gives us something to work towards. The possibility of a Cycling

Weekend to Norfolk or Devon was raised, but realistically, this wouldn't be happening until 2021 at the earliest.

General Cycling

We are actively looking at encouraging schools to run Bike Safety courses and for the council to keep our cycle paths in good repair. The government are encouraging people to use their bikes and have <u>promised a £2m package</u> to make it easier for people to use bikes to get around. HCC want to ensure that Harlow with it's existing cycle path structure are part of the dialogue for the area.

Fursty Fridays/ Racing / Time Trialling /Sportives / Audax UK

As with club rides all other activities are cancelled or postponed at the moment.
